



# Safety Checking Electrical Appliances

## Overview

This competency provides the knowledge and skills to enable the learner to undertake inspection, testing and tagging procedures using portable appliance testers. Checks will be made on single phase, low voltage and portable electrical equipment in accordance with the requirements of AS/NZS 3760. This competency does not cover the inspection of three phase or RCD's.

The learner should have a clear understanding of the range of work limitations to be employed prior to commencing the course.
