**High Risk Work Licensing E-alert**  
September 2010

**First 'Licence to Perform High Risk Work' issued**

When applicants for classes of High Risk Work are successfully assessed by a Registered Assessor, they will receive the new photo licence that can be used anywhere in Australia. It also means that holders of existing certificates or 'tickets' are able to convert their qualifications to the new licence over time.

**The High Risk Work Conversion Line is open for business**

Holders of qualifications issued before 3 April 1995 are encouraged to apply to convert their current tickets.

There are three simple steps:

**STEP ONE** - check the issue date of your oldest ticket

**STEP TWO** - check its expiry date at [www.safework.sa.gov.au](http://www.safework.sa.gov.au)

**STEP THREE** - contact SafeWork SA on 1300 975 909 to start the conversion process.

There is plenty of time to convert existing qualifications. Tickets issued before 3 April 1995 (or 'old-style' tickets) will be the first to expire. These must all be converted to the new Licence to Perform High Risk Work by 1 September 2011. Other tickets will be phased out over the following four years.
