What do you learn on our course?

- Legislation – requirements under current Act and regulations
- The Machine – types, loads, stability, basic maintenance etc
- The Operation – steering, parking, approaching and lifting loads
- The Task – stacking/unstacking, manoeuvring, loading/unloading and transportation
- The Materials – packaging, pallets, drums, attachments and hazardous substances
- The Environment – floor stability, obstacles, pedestrians, confined spaces and slopes

Prerequisites: Participants must be at least 18 years of age

Course Costs: \$270 per participant

1-day course, - For experienced Forklift Operators is available and may include Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) & Practical Training & Assessment

Please note that from September 1 2010, Training Organisations will no longer be responsible for issuing Forklift Licenses. From this date all High Risk Work Licenses (including Forklift) will be issued by SafeWork SA (State Government) at a Services SA outlet or Post Office. The current cost for the Photo ID license is \$65. This is in addition to the cost of training.
