From July 1, 2011 South Australian White Cards are required to carry a photograph of the holder. Please be aware that photo ID will be required on the day of the course e.g. Drivers License, Student ID, Passport etc).

**White Card Re-issues:** White Cards can only be re-issued for people who undertook training with ATEC. Cost for a White Card Re-issue is \$22 (GST Inc.)
