



National Restricted Electrical License

(Disconnect and reconnect fixed wired electrical equipment connected to a low voltage supply)

Overview:

Do you need to Disconnect and Reconnect power or electricity? The NREL course is directed at people in need of this qualification for their current employment.

Course Costs: \$580.00 p/p - 1 week course

\$130.00 p/p - *Wednesday night practical sessions (if required) **N.B:** this is a one-off fee that covers however many sessions the trainer deems necessary to assess competence.

Course duration: One week block
Mon to Fri - 8:00am to 4:30pm

*Wednesday night practical sessions (as determined by trainer)
Wed. 5pm - 8pm

* Students taking this course are likely to have varying levels of knowledge and experience; hence it is possible that some students may complete the course in less time than others. ONLY the trainer will decide when the student has achieved all the competencies and if necessary, some students may be required to return on Wednesday evenings to achieve competency in the practical assessments.

N.B: The course cost remains the same even if the student is deemed competent before the 5 days are completed. However there is an additional cost associated with weekly practical sessions (refer Course Costs above).

Course Delivery: Theory and practical

Course Content: **UEENEOP001B** - This unit covers disconnecting and reconnecting fixed wired electrical equipment. This may be incidental to or a primary and regular function of work related to a principle work function.

It encompasses working safely, identifying supply arrangements, following isolation procedures, selecting and using testing and measuring devices, terminating and connecting cables and conductors, safely testing and reporting and excludes disconnecting or reconnecting circuits at a switchboard or to general electrical accessories (including switches, socket outlets, circuit protective devices etc); or installation of or alteration to any part of the fixed electrical wiring system (defined as electrical installing work).
