



DIPLOMA IN OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY (BSB51307)

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who coordinate and maintain the OHS program within an organisation. Individuals would possess a sound theoretical knowledge base and use a range of specialised, technical or managerial competencies to plan, carry out and evaluate their own work and the work of others with safety responsibilities.

On successful completion of the program you will be issued with a nationally recognised certificate that will confirm your skills and competence in Work Health Safety. This qualification can also lead to an Advanced Diploma level qualification within the Work Health and Safety area.

Delivery Methods

An ATEC Trainer will meet with you to arrange a training program to suit your needs. This program can be delivered entirely on site through face-to-face training, theory classes and / or practical sessions involving small groups and individual activities. A training manual covering the selected units is provided to each participant and includes materials used in the training sessions and assessment and reference materials. Much of the training is based around simulated activities that reflect workplace processes and related tasks, and an ATEC Trainer will meet with you to negotiate and develop an appropriate training plan and confirm delivery modes.

Assessment Methods

May include questioning, demonstrated previous experience, observation in the workplace, tests, written reports, project examinations and other appropriate assessment methods depending on the unit requirements.

Pre-requisites

There are no pre-requisites for individual units of competency that make up this qualification. However, completion of a Certificate IV in Occupational Health and Safety or experience in a Work Health Safety role in the workplace would be beneficial prior to undertaking this qualification.

Course Fees

\$4,200 (includes learning resources)

For this qualification you are required to select 8 elective units, 5 Group A units and 3 electives from either Group A or B.
