



## FREE TRAINING FOR A NATIONALLY RECOGNISED QUALIFICATION

This qualification could equate to the first year of an Electrical apprenticeship or can fast track you into the electrical industry as a trades assistant or other electrical related occupation. Participants will be introduced to the Electrical Industry and cover the occupational, health and safety aspects as well as teamwork, communication, measurements & calculations and utilisation of a range of electrical tools, equipment and systems etc.
