



## FREE TRAINING FOR A NATIONALLY RECOGNISED QUALIFICATION

This qualification will allow you to work in the Manufacturing Industry as a Metal Fabricator/Welder and could lead to a career in areas such as mining, Oil refineries/Petro chemical plants, wineries, building ships/submarines and structural manufacturing (e.g. stairways, buildings etc).
